Thank you for your interest in the 23rd Annual Wamego Tulip Festival! Our community is quite proud of our annual spring festival and we are happy that you want to be a part of this wonderful tradition.

The following application is required of each organization that would like a space in the non-profit area. Please note: Electricity is not available in the area of the park that is allocated for non-profit spaces.

Non-profit organizations will be offered a 12' X 12' space near the children's amusement area on the northeast side of the city park. Non-profit organizations that use the space for informational purposes only shall receive the space for free. Any non-profit organization that wishes to sell items as a fundraiser must submit the \$25.00 fundraising booth fee with the application. All non-profit organization fundraising applications will be subject to approval by the Tulip Festival Committee. Organizations can purchase booth space in the inside or outside craft booth areas, as long as the items to be sold are hand crafted/hand made items. Craft vendor applications are available at our website www.wamegochamber.com. Each applicant will be sent an acceptance letter with further information.

Any vendors that breakdown before the close of the festival may not be allowed to return to the following year as a vendor. The vendors are responsible for set-up and tear down of the booth space.
- All Non-Profit spaces will be approximately 12' X 12' in size and be located in the "children's area" at the north side of the park, unless otherwise stated.
- APPLICATION DEADLINE IS FRIDAY APRIL 7th, 2010.
- A detailed description of your plans for your space must be printed on, or sent with the application.
- Non-profit organizations shall not sell any items unless they remit the \$25.00 fundraising booth fee and the application is reviewed and approved by the Tulip Festival Committee.
- IF YOUR ORGANIZATION WOULD LIKE TO BE PLACED IN THE CRAFT VENDOR AREA, THE ORGANIZATION MUST SELL HAND-CRAFTED/HAND-MADE ITEMS AND SUBMIT THE APPROPRIATE APPLICATION WITH THE APPROPRIATE FEES.

- Setup is on Friday, April 16th from 11:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. or Saturday, April 17th from 5:30 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.
